In a refreshing twist, there was no pushback from climate scepticism—a testament to the power of understanding your audience and preparing well.

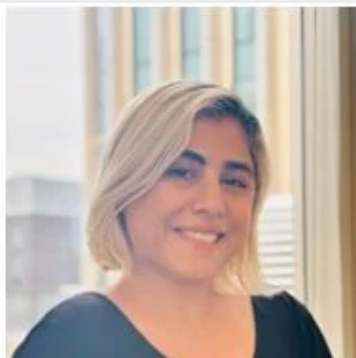
